Steamboat Minnehaha to Big Island

One of the original streetcar boats that had been scuttled in 1926, the *Minnehaha* was raised in 1980 and completely restored. It was returned to limited service on the lake in 1996 as an exhibit of the Minnesota Transportation Museum, now part of the Museum of Lake Minnetonka.
